

In the 1970's discrimination against women prevented that. After college she moved to New York City, eventually starting her own import/export company; later a wine tasting business and dance studio. In her early 40's her health began to fail. She began to study Reiki, Reflexology and Acupressure. Because of its success, she is now an Advanced Practitioner of *Energy Medicine*. She also teaches stress management techniques to individuals and large groups when she isn't skiing, traveling or reading. And her civil suit against the Feds? Her results were mailed to her in 1993: she had passed the Foreign Service exam in 1977.
